Field Operational Rules

(Updated for 2010)

1. You must be a member of the Mather Aerospace Modelers and have a current AMA and club license in your possession or be a guest of and accompanied by such member to be permitted to fly.
2. Those under the influence of alcohol will not be permitted to fly.
3. No alcoholic beverages are allowed at the flying site.
4. No smoking while flying.
5. Mufflers are required on all engines .15 and larger unless in a scale model of a full size aircraft.
6. The AMA safety code will be strictly adhered to and enforced.
7. The airspace above the parking area and to the west of the flying site is off limits to powered aircraft.
8. Gliders are authorized to launch and fly in the field west of Eagles Nest Road.
9. Pilots must observe a 400ft ceiling limit. When a full scale aircraft is spotted in the area all models must immediately descend to the lowest safe altitude practical or land.
10. All vehicles will be parked in the designated parking area. The pits and runway are off limits to vehicles.
11. Pilots will stand in one of the four flying stations while flying. Small and slow electric planes may fly in the designated helicopter hovering area when it is not used by helicopters.
12. Pilots taxiing or flying should let others know of their intention to take off or to land.
13. Pilots operating models must display their current AMA and club membership cards for ease of identification.
14. Each individual is responsible and liable for any accident or damage caused by the operation of their transmitter without having the proper frequency reserved on the frequency board.
15. One run-up is allowed in the pit. Use the areas north or south of the flying stations for tuning.
16. No activity other than that related to RC model aircraft is allowed.
17. No flying before sunrise and after sunset.
18. All gates must be closed and locked when the field is not occupied.
19. No cell phone use in the pits or on the flight line. Cell phones may be used in the parking lot.
20. A fire extinguisher and First Aid kit is located in the storage container. If access to the storage container is not available each pilot is responsible for having access to his/her own Fire extinguisher and First Aid kit.
21. Violators of the club operational and or safety rules may lose their field use privileges and/or be expelled from the club.
22. A member who brings a guest to the field will be held fully accountable for all actions by that guest. Safe flying practices and adherence to all clubs rules is mandatory. Failure to properly enforce safety and club rules will lead to immediate disciplinary action.

By signing MASM membership application member acknowledges that he/she has read and understands the Field Operational Rules for Mather Aerospace Modelers. With the signature on membership application member promises to abide by these rules and regulations for own safety and the safety of others.
