The usual suspects gather while the tables fill up.

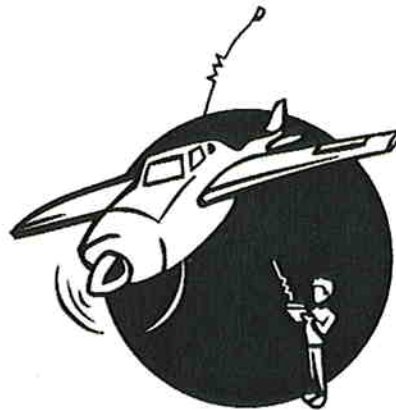
Fly Model Airplanes for FREE at Mather Aerospace Modelers Open Field Day
