November Meeting

Presidents Message

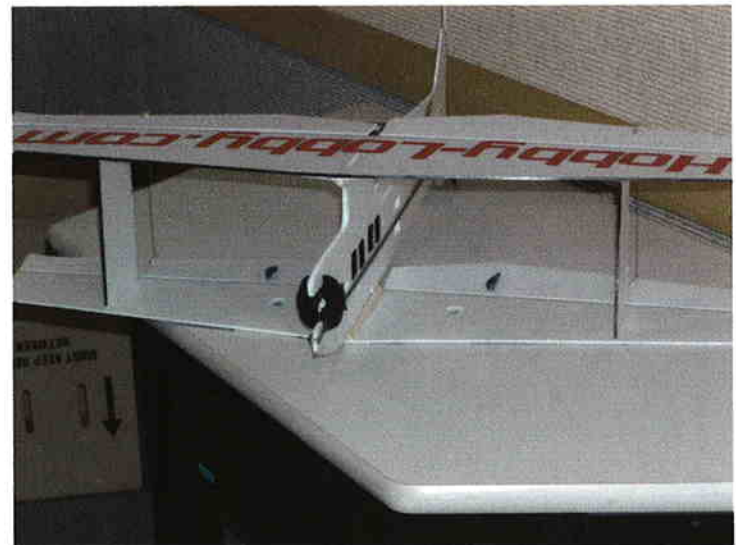
New Members: Two new members attended the meeting, welcome Tim Lord and Bart Holden.

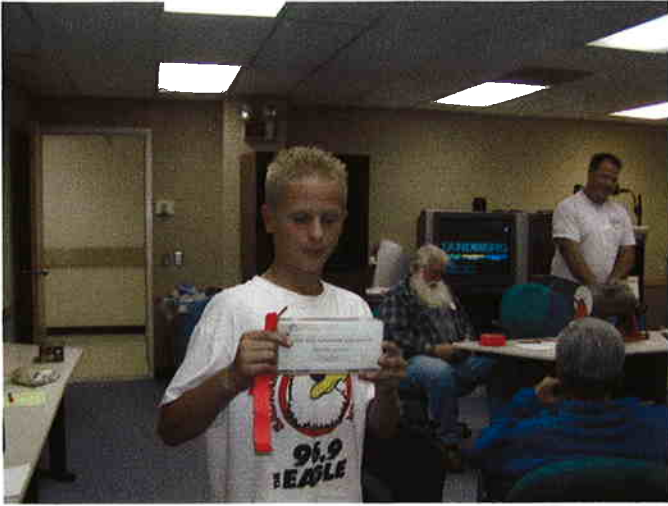
Show and Tell:

Dave showed us the latest contribution from Chip Hydes, the Raptor. This plane will be on the market soon.

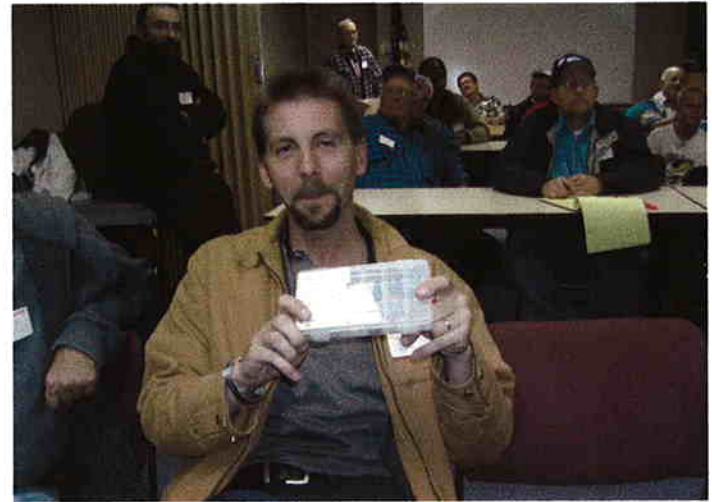

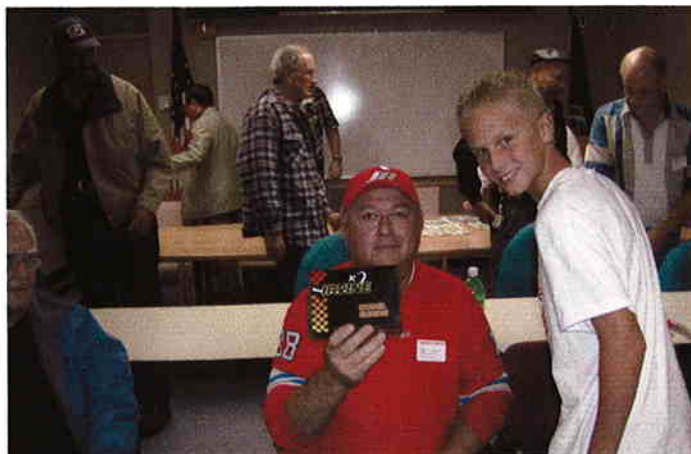
Mike was double winner of servo arms and new screw assortment



Larry took home Tiger 400 ARF

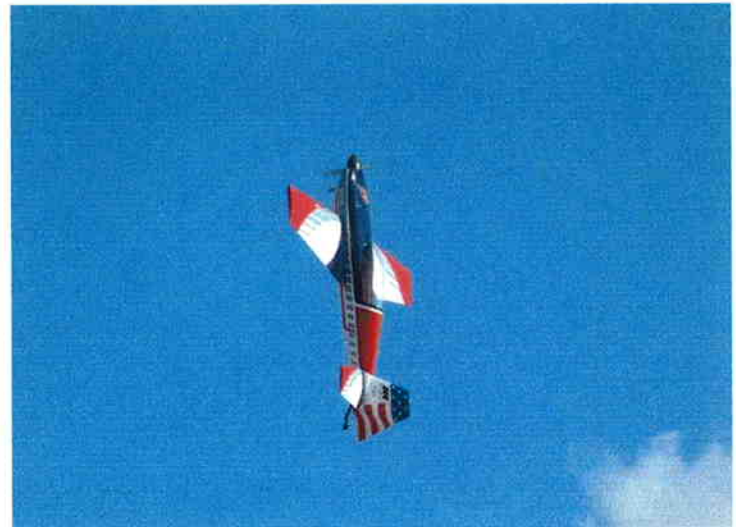


Dave scored the second screw assortment
