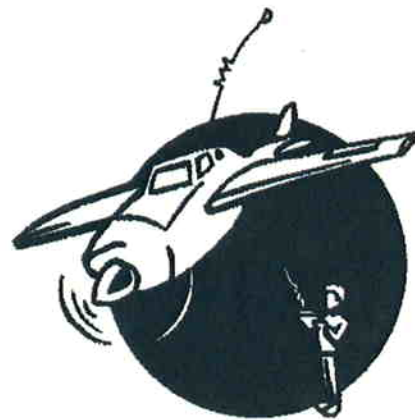
## Fly Model Airplanes for FREE at Mather Aerospace Modelers
